Hygiene Kits for Disaster Relief

February is “Hygiene Kit” month. Our church, along with many other churches, will be collecting hygiene kits for disaster relief, and we hope that you will participate in this project. The list of items needed for each kit has changed this year to better serve the people in need. You can put your own kit together, or purchase all the items for a kit from Nancy Stuart for \$5 per kit. If ordering from Nancy, please order and pay her by February 15. Items to be included in the kits: :

- One wash cloth
- Bath-size bar of soap (in original packing)
- Toothbrush (in original packaging)
- Travel-size toothpaste (3.4 oz. or less, with expiration date of at least 1 year)
- Fingernail or toenail clippers (packaging removed)
- One wide-tooth comb (with at least 6 inches of teeth; no pocket combs or picks)
- Travel-size shampoo (3.4.oz or less, NEW only)
- Travel-size lotion (3.4 oz. or less, NEW only)
- Travel-size stick deodorant (3.4.oz.or less)

If you are assembling your own kit, please put these nine items in a one-gallon plastic zip-lock bag and place them in the designated box in the new fellowship hall by Feb. 22. We will be meeting after church on Sunday, March 15th to assemble the other kits. Hope you can help !

Blue Ridge Mobile Food Pantry

The Blue Ridge Mobile Food Pantry, which originated at Maysville Presbyterian Church as the first mobile food pantry in the Commonwealth, continues to make local distributions. The distribution site was moved from our church to the Crystal Cathedral property in Dillwyn due to the need for a safer traffic pattern. Volunteers are always needed. You are welcome to join in from 9:30 to 11:30 am on the second and fourth Friday of each month to help with the distributions. “God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them” 1 John 4:16β (NRSV)

I'm sure you've heard that February is the month of Love. I'm also sure you know why popular culture claims this month in the name of Love — you got it — Valentine's Day. For me, however, February is a month of love for some additional reasons. Oh, sure, I don't ignore Valentine's Day and I try to remember to make or do something special for Genevieve.
